

**No Meeting of the Aberffraw Community Council
During March 2020, due to COVID-19 regulations
Items of Concern were discussed via telephone and/or email**

1. New Clerk introduced to Councillors. Role during “lockdown”:
 - a. ensure Councillors are kept up to date on COVID-19 Regulations
 - b. liaise with Bodorgan Estate, Ynys Mon Council, One Voice Wales
 - c. create Facebook Page for notices during “lockdown”
2. Village Hall
 - a. emails forwarded to Councillors for information, discussion and responses
 - b. phone calls received from Village Hall Management Committee, information emailed to Councillors for information, discussion and responses
3. Keep Wales Tidy
 - a. proposed by Peter Owen
 - b. grant available for planting of wildlife gardens etc.
 - c. it was agreed that the planting would be at the Village Hall
 - d. application was submitted by the Clerk
4. Woodland Trust
 - a. notification of grant availability for hedging
 - b. it was agreed that the Clerk would submit the application
 - c. it was agreed that the planting would be at the edge of the Playing Field
 - d. Woodland Trust postponed the grant due to COVID-19 regulations
5. Burial Plots
 - a. Ynys Mon Council request for available plots in the Aberffraw Cemetery
 - b. the Chairman and Clerk measured available space
 - c. questionnaires were completed
6. Car Park at the Old Bridge
 - a. Bodorgan Estate instruction to close the car park during “lockdown”
 - b. the closure had already been carried out via Villagers
7. Lane to Saint Cwyfan’s Church
 - a. Bodorgan Estate instruction to close the lane to the church in the sea
 - b. a temporary closure had already been carried out via Villagers
 - c. Bodorgan Estate placed a boulder at the end of the lane to prohibit visitors
8. Audit Procedure
 - a. the closure of the financial statement was being handled by the previous Clerk with updates to Councillors and the new Clerk
