

**No Meeting of the Aberffraw Community Council
During May 2020, due to COVID-19 regulations
Items of Concern were discussed via telephone and/or email**

1. Covid-19
 - a. emails received from Welsh Government, Ynys Mon Council, One Voice Wales on Lockdown Procedures, Funding, Health in the Community etc. All emails circulated to Community Council Members for discussion and posted on the Aberffraw Facebook Page.
2. Allotments
 - a. renewal payments received, logged and banked
3. Village Concerns Covid-19 and Visitors
 - a. owners of Holiday Homes coming to self-isolate in the village. The Community Council have no jurisdiction over people staying in their own houses. It was noted that the Police were calling on all Holiday Homes in the area.
 - b. obscene notice boards appearing at the edge of the village. Concern over the language and the impression given of the village. The Community Council have no jurisdiction over the removal of the signs. Police and Highways Department were notified.
4. Planning Applications
 - a. planning application for land on Glan y Mor. Objections issued.
5. Audit
 - a. external audit information received, detailing the process for this year's audits. All emails forwarded to the Community Council for information.
6. One Voice Wales
 - a. membership renewed.
7. Keep Wales Tidy
 - a. discussions on feasibility of planting during Lockdown.
8. Bodorgan Estate
 - a. Bodorgan Estate requested a lease be signed between the estate and the Community Council for the area known as the Car Park (Hen Bont) at the Old Bridge. This was declined.
